



Registering for Your Admission Testing

How to Register for the ISEE or the SSAT

Morristown Beard School requires either the Independent School Entrance Exam (ISEE) or the Secondary School Admission Test (SSAT) as part of our application process. Applications for all students applying to Morristown Beard are reviewed holistically, and the admission test scores are weighted in the application review process as one data point in your student's application.

The **Independent School Entrance Examination (ISEE)** is a standardized test whose purpose is to help admissions committees at private schools evaluate the potential performance of applicants. More than 1,200 independent schools around the world accept ISEE scores as part of their admissions processes.

The **Secondary School Admission Test (SSAT)** is a standardized exam used to assess the abilities of students who want to attend an independent school. It is not an IQ test; rather, it measures your student's verbal, math, and reading skills. The purpose of the SSAT is to help admission committees determine whether applicants will be successful at their school.

Morristown Beard School does not have a preference for one test over the other. We recommend trying the sample or practice tests offered on each platform's website to see which format your student prefers.

Morristown Beard School does not recommend that families do much, if any, test prep for the ISEE or the SSAT, nor do we recommend that students take the test multiple times.

Admission tests must be taken between July 1, 2026 and January 7, 2027.

We encourage applicants to register for their desired test date early in the admission season as seats for these tests fill up quickly. There are both at-home and on-site testing options available; please check all of the options as you register.

Testing Score Reports are only accepted directly from the testing organizations. Please provide the testing organization with the following appropriate code in order to forward the results to MBS. This is the fastest way to make sure your student's test results arrive in time for the application deadline:

- ISEE: 310845
- SSAT: 5200

Results must be received by our offices no later than January 11, 2027. It generally takes between 3-4 days for test results to arrive. Please schedule your student's test date with enough time for results to arrive by the deadline.

The MBS Admission Office will update the status of the Admission Testing section of your Veracross application when we receive your student's score report from the testing service.
